James Habersham, Jr. built this stately Georgian mansion in 1771. This wealthy planter's home held many secret meetings, which helped secure the independence of the 13 colonies from England. Today as a unique restaurant and tavern, groups can enjoy elegant southern dining in Savannah's only 18th century mansion.

You will be seated in the beautiful Ballroom located on the 2nd level. During lunch, someone from the staff at the Olde Pink House will give a brief overview of the house and the history of James Habersham, the original owner.

After lunch, we will walk over to Leopold's for a scoop of delicious ice cream. Leopold's Ice Cream was founded in 1919 by three immigrant brothers from Greece: George, Peter and Basil Leopold. They learned the art of candy and dessert from an uncle who had already settled in America. The brothers perfected the secret formulas and created the world famous Leopold's VeriBest™ ice cream. They opened their own ice cream parlor on the corner of Gwinnett and Habersham streets in Savannah, where two streetcar lines intersected. Many a rider would jump off the streetcar and entreat the motorman to wait as they got a frozen delight!
